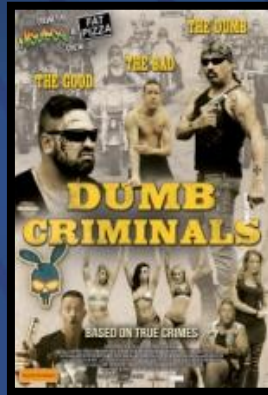
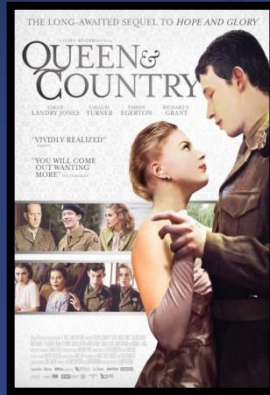
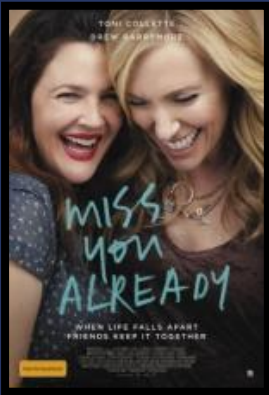
MARTIAN, THE
