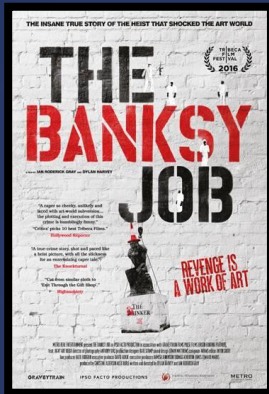

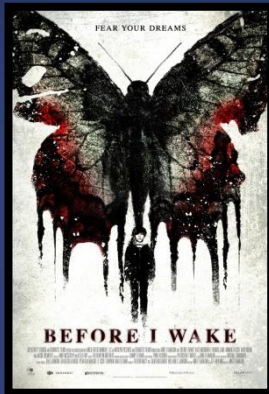
BANKSY JOB, THE
