The social structure forces Kate to accept an arranged marriage with a member of another pack to unite the wolves for peace. But Kate and Humphrey are captured by park rangers and sent cross-country as part of a wolf repopulation project. Kate is determined to return home and Humphrey offers to help. Meanwhile, he starts to understand the importance of family.
