

Nothing to report

Guild injuries, near misses or hazards reported for the month of August:

- Staff member experience a burn of middle part of left hand, resulting in four fingers swelling and blistering at Concept Coffee Co.,
 - Whilst using the boiling water tap on the coffee machine to fill a coffee cup for a customer, the staff member fumbled the cup which spilled on their hand, the individual was then scared to drop the cup and held her hand under the running boiling tap for a few seconds when in shock.
 - Immediate action consisted of having hand under running water for 10-15 minutes and then continued applying burn gel for the next 30mins - 1 hour
 - As a result, action items consisted of:
 - Team Leader advised that all non-trivial burns victims to be taken to medical centre, and
 - Staff advised to take extra care when using boiling water tap.
- Staff member slipped on wet floor in Café wash up area at Guild Café Central
 - o Investigation still to be conducted
