When you submit

Triple check the file

If you have issues, send an email to your UC straight away

If you're going to submit late, always email your UC

Option 3: Late Withdrawal

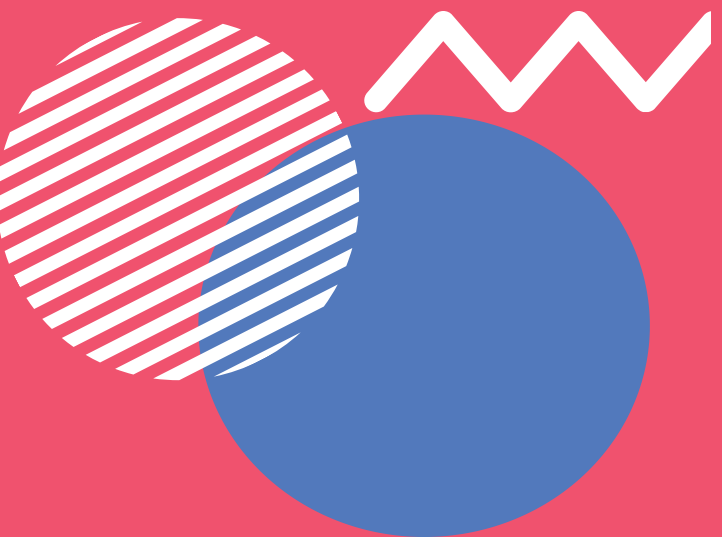
Pay for the unit, but it doesn't affect your transcript
