Five (5) Postgraduate Student Committee Councillors, at least two (2) of whom shall not identify as a man

Eligibility Criteria:

A candidate for any International Student Committee position must be an international student.

A candidate for any Postgraduate Student Committee position must be a postgraduate student.

A candidate for any Committee Faculty position must be enrolled in that faculty.

A candidate for Postgraduate Student Committee Vice President – Research must be a Higher Degree by Research Student

Further Information of the eligibility criteria can be found in the *Student (Guild Council) Regulations 2018* the Committee Constitutions.

The nomination period is open from **the 10th of October 2pm** until the close of nominations – **14th of October 2pm**. Late nominations will not be accepted.

Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer either in person, through Guild Reception, or by completing the online nominations form.

Candidates may choose to include a statement of up to 300 words if they wish.
