On satellite campuses, University staff members on that campus act as acceptable witnesses.						

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A candidate shall be eligible to be an NUS Delegate if they:

- (a) meet the specific qualifications and/or disqualifications in Regulation 18 of the *National Union of Students Regulations* 2018, namely a delegate shall:
 - i. be a student who Is represented by the Curtin Student Guild;
 - ii. not be a delegate of another member organisation of the National Union of Students;
- (b) to meet the requirements of (a)(i), a student must hold the general qualifications listed in Schedule B(1) of the *Student Guild (Guild Council) Regulations 2018*, namely:
 - i. be an enrolled student at least seven (7) days prior to the opening of nominations;
 - ii. be a Guild Member at least seven (7) days prior to the opening of nominations;
 - iii. study at Curtin University at a Curtin University campus in Western Australia or otherwise reside in the State of Western Australia; and
 - iv. is enrolled in an award course at Curtin University.
