IMPACT RATING DEFINITIONS

LOW IMPACT - 1	Minimal barriers. Most students can attend comfortably with little to no additional planning.
MEDIUM IMPACT - 2	Some barriers. Students may need to plan ahead or make adjustments based on their access needs.
HIGH IMPACT - 3	Additional barriers that may cause discomfort, stress, or exclusion. Students should review details carefully before attending and plan carefully.

A Reduced Noise Period will run from 1:30pm to 2:30pm, during which amplified music will be turned off. However, general crowd noise will still be present during this time.

Toilets	MEDIUM	Accessible toilets available close by event area	Accessible toilets are available nearby, but reaching them may require some extra travel time. Accessible all-gender toilets are located throughout the event area; however, not all of these are universally accessible. You can use the event map to find the nearest appropriate facility. Universally Accessible Toilets (UAT) can be found inside the Curtin Library (Building 105) on every level, with clear signage throughout the building. The closest UATs to this event in the Library are: Level 2 – Room 216 Level 3 – Room 313
Heat / Sun / Weather	MEDIUM	Event is outside but some shelter/shade is provided around all stalls only	Heat exposure possible; hydration and sun protection recommended. Free suncream can be found in Guild Reception, building 106F
Strobe / Flashing Lights	LOW	No strobe, flashing lights or audio visual lighting	Safe for sensory-sensitive attendees.
Seating	MEDIUM	Some seating available within event area	Please see sensory map for any designated seating and rest areas.
Accessible Path of Travel	MEDIUM	A mixture of even and uneven ground Some paths may be narrow Small sections of ramps have a gradient greater than 1.14 and elevators available <u>outside</u> of event area, outside of the path of travel.	Some routes may require caution or assistance. Smells	HIGH	Some strong smells may be present and you may be close to strong smells during the event	You may be in close proximity to the following smells while attending this event which could trigger discomfort or sensory overwhelm: - food, perfumes, markers/textas, glue and other smells associated with crowds.
18+ / Alcohol	LOW	All ages event. No alcohol served	No alcohol is available at this event. Some stalls may feature alcohol-related promotions (e.g., Curtin Tav, Mixology Society). Alcohol-free options promoted. Provided to support attendees who prefer to avoid alcohol-related triggers.
Wayfinding / Signage	LOW	An event map is available in printed and digital formats A sensory map is available in printed and digital formats Ammenities are well signposted	Event map AND sensory map available in digital and print. Clear signage throughout.

Lighting	MEDIUM	The venue is well-lit, but is held outdoors during summer with full-sun expected.	The event is held outdoors, during daylight hours and is well-lit. Sun protection such as hat and sunglasses may provide more comfort from the sun
Parking	MEDIUM	Parking (including ACROD) is located within 500m of the venue and there is an accessible path of travel to the venue	Road works / Closures: Avoid parking along beazley ave in PE2 due to road closures expected in that area. Parking zones, including ACROD can be found on the campus map here: https://properties.curtin.edu.au/campus-maps/ Parking on campus is limited, and no single parking area is recommended for this event. You may need extra time to find a bay. To help reduce congestion, students are encouraged to use curtinlink , a free, bookable mini-bus service that operates within nearby suburbs: https://properties.curtin.edu.au/getting-here/curtinlink/
Rest Areas	MEDIUM	A designated rest area is available within the event area and is marked on the sensory map and clearly signposted. The rest area can only accommodate a limited amount of people.	The rest area's are located at: 1. Guild Equity Space - Accessibility Department (building 106F) . This is slightly within the event area and may not be as quite as expected. The area can only accommodate 4-5 people at one time. 2. Clubs Hub - Theatre (building 106A). This is slightly out of the event area. The room is soundpadded and can accommodate up to 20 people at one time. Both rooms are air-conditioned, multiple powerpoints & fidgets available.
