9.2. Protest for Deaths in Custody

Content Warning: Death, Suicide, Self Harm

Motion: That the Representation Board:

- a) **condemns** the Labor WA government for their overseeing of the racist police and prison system.
- b) **hold** the WA Labor government responsible for the deaths of 10 people in WA incarceration this year alone.

9.3. Visas for Palestinian Refugees!

Motion: That the Representation Board:

- a) **condemns** the ALP for its refusal to grant humanitarian visas to most Palestinian refugees;
- b) **condemns** the ALP for its refusal to grant permanent residency for most Palestinian refugees;
- c) **condemns** the ALP for the racist, unjust screening processes its government has applied to Palestinian refugees – and for asserting that they may pose a terror threat to Australia;
- d) **condemns** the ALP for allowing Australian citizens to travel to Israel to serve in the IDF, and return home freely and without consequence;
- e) **endorses** and publicly supports the next pro-Palestine protest called by Friends of Palestine WA (FOPWA).
