Palestinian refugees – and for asserting that they may pose a terror threat to Australia;

d) **condemns** the ALP for allowing Australian citizens to travel to Israel to serve in the IDF, and return home freely and without consequence;

e) **endorses** and publicly supports the next pro-Palestine protest called by Friends of Palestine WA (FOPWA).
